Guild-	-4-5 adults -30-33 students -Meet on the last Wednesday of the month for the Guild Activity during the activity block
Guild Advisors-	-the 4-5 adults who lead the Guild -Meet on the first Wednesday of the month from 7:30-8:30 a.m.
Guild Advisory Block (GAB) -	-1 Guild Advisor -10-12 students (mixed level students) -Meet Mon., Tues, Thurs, Fri. from 9:11-9:36
Guild Council-	-Moderator: Sister Maryann Tarquinio -4 representatives from each Guild -Entire Council meets 1st & 3rd Mondays of the month after school. Executive Council meets 2 nd & 3 rd Mondays of the month after school.
Guild Marquis Events-	-Sporting events, social events, working Open House/Grade School events, award night events, academic competitions, etc.(see calendar) -Student attendance is recorded and points are awarded to the guild for participation/attendance -Guilds are responsible for 3 Marquis events to keep record of attendance.
Guild Major Events-	- Homecoming Dances, Turkey Trot, Spirit Week, etc. (see calendar) -Student attendance is recorded and points are awarded to the guild for participation/attendance -Guilds are responsible for 1 Major event per year. This includes the planning of and carrying forth of the event.
